

LODGING

Aplace Antwerp (Vrijdagmarkt 1; [aplace.be](#)) has four lovely, recently renovated rooms, two suites and two apartments on a quiet square in the city centre. The friendly innkeeper, Karin, gives guests insider tips about the city and sometimes brings cupcakes, too. Suites from €125. The **Hotel O Kathedraal** (Handschoenmarkt 3; [hotelhotelo.com](#)) is as central as it gets — right across the square from the cathedral. Under the hotel's white stepped-gable roof, there are 23 minimalist rooms, some with peek-a-boo showers, as well as a downstairs bar and bookshop. Doubles from €99.
